General Description of available colours

When viewing the Colour Atlas the following pattern can be used on the specified pages.

Page Number	Colours
P.G1	PG1.H5 to PG1.A9 (any colour below the 5 line)
P.G2	PG2.A5 to PG2.H9 (any colour below the 5 line)
P.03	P03.A4, P03.B4 P03.A5, P03.B5 P03.A6, P03.B6, P03.C6 P03.A7, P03.B7, P03.C7 P03.A8, P03.B8, P03.C8, P03.D8 P03.A9, P03.B9, P03.C9, P03.D8
P.04	P04.A4, P04.B4 P04.A5, P04.B5 P04.A6, P04.B6, P04.C6 P04.A7, P04.B7, P04.C7 P04.A8, P04.B8, P04.C8, P04.D8 P04.A9, P04.B9, P04.C9, P04.D8

This pattern is then repeated on the following pages up to and including P.18.

Other colours will be considered for signs, front doors and minor trim elements but their acceptability will depend on exposure and orientation.

Colorbond colours

Colorbond sheeting for wall and roof cladding is permitted; however, there is limited choice of standard colours that can be used for predominant wall and roof elements.

These are:

Woodland Grey,

Bushland,

Loft,

Monument,

Deep Ocean,

Iron Stone,

Windspray (in some cases if not visible from distant vantage points such as Mount Bogong or surrounding ridge lines)

The use of highly reflective from the Colorbond Metallic range is not permitted with the exception of Facade.

The use of metals such as copper or zinc is permitted.
