## Top Tips For Snow-Smart Driving

### **TOP TIPS FOR SNOW-SMART DRIVING**

#### 1.Before the journey starts...

~ Check tyres, battery, brakes, cooling system, engine & windscreen

~ **Always carry chains** & *gloves to fit them*, a torch & a garbage bag to avoid wet knees

~ Add **Anti-Freeze** to the vehicle's radiator

~ Got a **Diesel Vehicle**? Add '**Alpine Diesel**' mix to the fuel tank - available at Alpine Region Service Stations.

**2.Ice & snow – take it slow!** Avoid sudden braking or acceleration on snow or ice... Allow plenty of room between you & the car in front... If you hit ice, stay calm & break gently, to slowly regain traction...

**3.**Take corners **slowly & steer gently to avoid skidding**... Never brake fast if the vehicle skids, instead, ease off the accelerator & steer slightly into the direction of the skid, until you regain control...

**4.**If stuck in snow, **do not spin the** wheels *or rev the vehicle* - this will dig the vehicle further into the snow... Instead, put the vehicle into as high a gear as possible & slowly manoeuvre the vehicle lightly forwards & backwards, then gently manoeuvre the vehicle out...

#### 5.Before Exiting the Mountain...

~ Ice & Snow – Remove it before you go!

~ **Clear ALL snow** from your vehicle before leaving the resort – there's a hefty fine & loss of demerit points for driving with snow on your roof

~ Carry an ice-scraper & use the heater & air conditioner

~ Never Pour Hot Water on Your Windscreen to Remove Snow - it will crack!

#### 6.When Exiting the Mountain...

~ Keep headlights on low beam at all times & **Engage Low Gear** as you drive down the mountain

~ **Don't** use Cruise Control – It restricts your ability to quickly react to poor road conditions & hazards... If the vehicle skids it will keep accelerating – not a good plan!

**7.No puffy ski jackets** on kids in car seats PLEASE - A thick jacket can loosen the seat's harness & a baby or child could easily slide out...
